E.g. for Panvel in similar tender the turnover for the qualification was 15 Crores and the Estimate was 100 Crores. 2. In pages and 9&15 Turnover is mentioned as 15 Crores but in Page 28 it is mentioned as 75 Crores. Hence clarify the same.	1. Considering the cost of work. 


